

Stakeholder Engagement to Inform the Design a Comparative Effectiveness Study of Treatment Options for Walking Difficulties in Multiple Sclerosis

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Many people with multiple sclerosis who are prescribed medication for symptomatic treatment of walking difficulties do not experience meaningful treatment benefits in response to the medication. In order to develop a clinical trial to compare treatment alternatives for this large group of patients, we are conducting research to ask patients, caregivers, and clinicians what they consider to be the most important indicators of treatment benefit and improvement of walking and function in daily life.
