The ASNR Education Committee has also worked with our Program Committee to provide two valuable Professional Development Sessions. In our first Professional Development Session, attendees will gain practical insights on how to apply data science and artificial intelligence to manage, visualize, and analyze data. Our second Professional Development session will give attendees a behind-the-scenes look at a mock scientific review section for NIH grants.

In addition to the sessions mentioned above, the 2025 Annual Meeting will include oral abstract presentations, two poster receptions, and updates from ASNR during our Business Meeting.
